Freelance Creative Facilitator Opportunity

Application Deadline: Monday 30th June 2025 at 4:00pm

Keighley Creative are looking for a number of freelance creative facilitators to deliver and lead public access drop-in workshops as part of *The Big Craft Spectacular* workshop series funded by The Leap.

Who are Keighley Creative?

Keighley Creative is an arts charity operating in the heart of Keighley, co-creating and delivering exciting projects and fun activities with local artists, communities, organisations and businesses.

What is *The Big Craft Spectacular (Big Crafty Doo-Dah)*?

The BIG Craft Spectacular (more fondly known as *The Big Crafty Doo-Dah*) is an expansion of our family workshop programme. In 2025 Keighley Creative will be delivering 12 family-friendly arts and crafts workshops.

The aim of the project is to engage Keighley families who have limited access to the arts. We will host pop-up workshops in public spaces, including the Airedale Shopping Centre, Keighley Market and 4 community outreach venues around Keighley.

During the workshops, participants will be offered a light food provision or a healthy snack. We know holiday hunger is an issue for families in Keighley and we want to support tackling this in a welcoming and dignified way.

As a workshop facilitator you will support our families & visitors, helping them to create a quality piece of art/craft to take away. The workshops should be process led, allowing participants to learn & practice new skills inspiring them to further create at home.

Our workshops may be the first time someone encounters the arts, so first impressions count. Their experience should be a positive one. We want people to feel welcome, encouraged, valued, inspired by their artwork and to know that everyone can be creative.

What is the opportunity?

We are looking for **up to 9 freelance creative facilitators** to design and deliver at least one of the following community workshops, linked to the themes set out by Keighley Creative.

The workshop dates are as follows:

August 2025 (final dates TBC) - 4 x community outreach workshops
20th August 2025- Airedale Shopping Centre (Holiday/Seaside Theme)
27th September 2025- Keighley Market (Harvest)
29th October 2025- Keighley Market (Halloween)
6th December 2025- Keighley Market (Christmas)
13th December 2025- Airedale Shopping Centre (Big Craft Spectacular Finale)!

The work will include:

- Co-designing the activity with the Keighley Creative Events Team.
- Liaising with the workshop assistant about workshop content.
- Carrying out & complete a risk assessment for the workshop
- Providing a resource list & prepare/source resources if needed
- Being responsible for setting up and clearing the workshop area
- Leading the delivery of the workshop), including managing assistant
- Evaluation, including recording visitor numbers and feedback comments
- Welcoming families to join in with the workshop
- Assisting children and families to take part in the activity
- Ensure the activity is delivered safely

The fee per workshop is as follows:

£260 (full day rate)

Material costs will be covered by Keighley Creative.

Personal Specification

- You must be over 18 to apply for this position
- You will need a full Enhanced DBS or be on the update service.

- You should have experience of planning and delivering visual arts workshops in a socially engaged way.
- You should have experience of working with a workshop assistant.
- You should have experience of writing risk assessments for activities.
- You should have a willingness to contribute to the overall evaluation of the project.
- You should have a professional and friendly approach to working with the public.
- You should have availability on at least one of the dates detailed above.
